SWVHJA Sanctioned

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

GREEN HUNTER: Open to horses only in their first or second year of showing over fences of any height at any show. Fences to be 2'6" and 3'. Both heights must be offered and judged together. To be eligible for green hunter status, horses may not have shown in more than three shows over fences at any show and never at a height greater than 2'3".

LOW HUNTER: Open to horses and ponies. Judged on performance, manners, way of going. Fences 3'.

ADULT AMATEUR: Open to adults mounted on horses or ponies. Judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Ponies shown by an adult may not be shown in the pony hunter division at the same horse show. Fences 3'.

CHILDREN'S HUNTER: Open to juniors mounted on horses. Judged on performance, manners and way of going. Fences 3'.

SWVHJA ADULT MEDAL: Open to SWVHJA adult amateur members. Same specs as Hunt Seat Medal.

SWVHJA HUNT SEAT MEDAL: Open to junior members of SWVHJA who have not reached their 18th birthday as of Dec. 1st. To be shown over a course of fences not to exceed 3' and includes two changes of direction and a combination. At least 6 riders, if available, must be called back to work on the flat. Martingales not allowed in flat phase. Each phase counts 50%. Same horse must be used for both phases.

ADULT EQUITATION ON THE FLAT: Open to amateurs. Same specs as Junior Flat.

JUNIOR EQUITATION ON THE FLAT: Open to juniors. Walk, trot, canter. Three entries to fill or may be combined with Adult Equitation if insufficient entries.

SWVHJA BEGINNER EQUITATION: Open to junior and amateur riders in their first year of showing. Fences 2'. No oxers permitted. Riders are eligible for one horse show year and may not enter divisions with fence heights exceeding 2'. This division not to count against rider's 2 year eligibility for the Intermediate Hunter division. To be judged on rider's position and control.

HOPEFUL HUNTER: Open to horses and ponies. To be judged on performance, manners and way of going. Fences 2'.

PLEASURE HUNTER: Open to horses and ponies ridden by amateurs. To be judged on performance, manners, and way of going.

INTERMEDIATE HUNTER: Open to anyone in their first or second year of showing, on horses or ponies, excluding the Beginner Equitation division. Fences 2'3". Once a rider shows over fences 2'6" or higher they are no longer eligible for Intermediate Hunter division in subsequent years. To be judged on performance, manners, and way of going. The rider may not jump higher than 2'6" at the same show.

RANDOLPH COLLEGE MEDAL: Open to junior and amateur riders mounted on horses or ponies and who have not qualified for a SWVHJA medal class or the Oak Ridge Medal during the current show year. Class to consist of 2 phases judged 50% each. The first phase will be the over fences phase of not less than 8 fences at 2'6" and may not contain a combination. The course must contain 2 changes of direction after the first fence. The second phase shall be ridden on the flat at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. Judges may choose from USEF 1-10. Martingales will be permitted in the flat phase. The same horse must be used for both phases of the class.

SPECIAL ADULT HUNTER: Open to amateurs on horses or ponies. Fences 2'6" or 2'9". Judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Same horse/rider combination cannot compete over fences higher than 2'9" at the same show. Offered split unless fewer than 3 entries.

SPECIAL CHILDREN'S HUNTER: Open to juniors. Fences 2'6" or 2'9". Special Adult specs.

LARGE PONY HUNTER: Open to ponies ridden by juniors. Ponies shown in this division may not be shown by an adult in any recognized division at the same horse show. Judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Large ponies (over 13.2h - not to exceed 14.2h) to jump 2'6". Divisions must be offered split, but if there are not three ponies in either the Small/Medium or Large Pony divisions, the divisions must be combined. Lines less than 72' must be set on appropriate distances.

SMALL/MEDIUM PONY HUNTER: Open to small (not to exceed 12.2h) ponies ridden by juniors. Smalls jump 2', mediums (over 12.2h, not to exceed 13.2h) jump 2'3". Three ponies required in first over fences class to fill the division or may be combined with larges.

SWVHJA PONY MEDAL: Open to current junior members of SWVHJA mounted on ponies. To be shown over a minimum of 6 jumps at the appropriate heights. A minimum of six riders, if available, must be called back to work on the flat. Martingales may not be used in the flat phase. Each phase to count 50%. The same pony must be used for both phases. Four entries are required to fill the class with a minimum of three to complete the class. If no Pony Medal is offered, a rider may compete on a pony in the Hunter Seat Medal. A rider cannot compete in both the Pony and the Hunter Seat Medals in one show, nor can they participate in both aforementioned finals in one year. SWVHJA Pony Medal contestants may compete throughout the year. The top twenty (20) point earners, with a minimum of 10 points, will be invited to compete in the Pony Medal Finals.

RULES & REGULATIONS: Entry Fees: \$12 per class, \$17 all Medal classes

The Glenmore Hunt, Mill Creek Farm, and SWVHJA officials, employees, and volunteers will not be held responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to any exhibitor, rider, trainer, spectator, groom or animal at this show.

All exhibitors must present a negative coggins report taken within one year on each animal admitted onto the show grounds.

All exhibitors must sign an Equine Activity Release/Waiver and parents or guardian of minor must sign release if under age 18.

Hard hats must be worn when mounted. All juniors MUST wear an ASTM approved helmet while mounted in accordance with the new ruling, effective January 2002, by USA Equestrian and SWVHJA.

DIRECTIONS TO MILL CREEK FARM:

I-81 North to Weyers Cave, Exit #235. Turn right; go about 1 mile to stoplight. Turn left on #276; go about 4 ½ miles. Turn right on #668 (white board fence on right before turn). Go one mile; turn left on #672; go ½ mile; turn left on #671. Mill Creek Farm is second farm on right.

I-81 South to Port Republic Road, Exit #245. Turn left on #659 for 7 miles past Mill Creek Church. Turn right on #673. Go one mile; right on #672; go ½ mile and turn on #671. Mill Creek Farm is second on right.

From 340 North, through Grottoes, left on #659 (Quick Stop on corner). Go through Port Republic; 4 miles, left on #673. Go one mile; right on #672. Go ½ mile and right on #671. Mill Creek Farm is second on right.
